Board Approved Graduation Requirement Changes



Community service hours are no longer required for graduation from Duncanville ISD. The Board of Trustees voted October 19, 2015, to remove community service hours as a graduation requirement, and as a result, to reduce the total graduation credits from 28½ credits to 28 total credits. Students are encouraged to continue acquiring volunteer hours, but not as a requirement for graduation. Students who have accumulated qualifying volunteer hours will be recognized by wearing an honor cord over their gowns at graduation ceremonies.

The 2016 Duncanville High School Graduation ceremony will be held Tuesday, May 31 at 7:30 pm at the Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center in Dallas.
