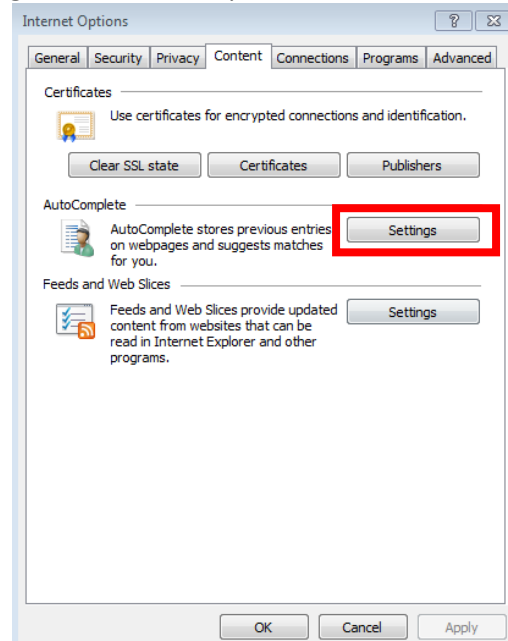
Click on **Tools** icon in upper right-hand corner.

Select **Internet Options**.

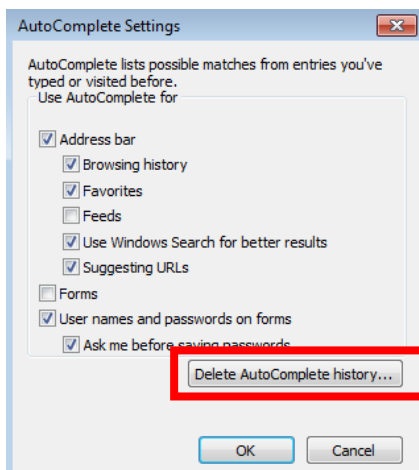


Select the **Content** tab.
