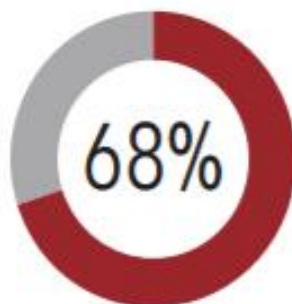

- Savings on college tuition and books per student.



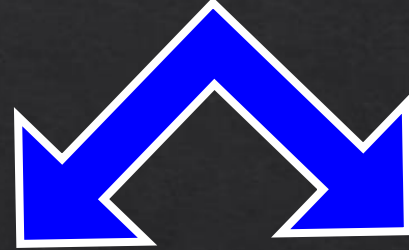
- U.S. jobs that will require a post-secondary education in the year 2020.

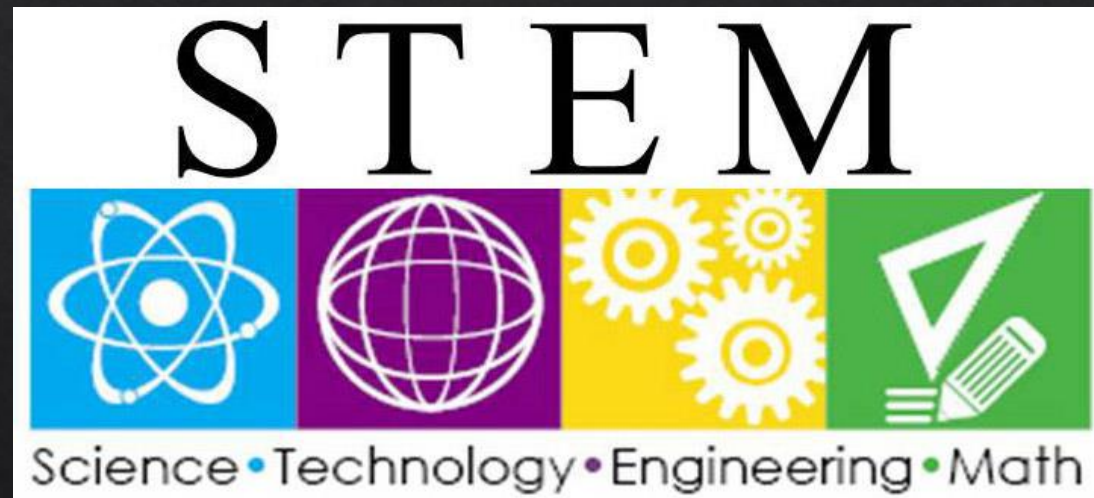
- Number of potential college credits students can earn in collegiate academies.

process for acceptance**

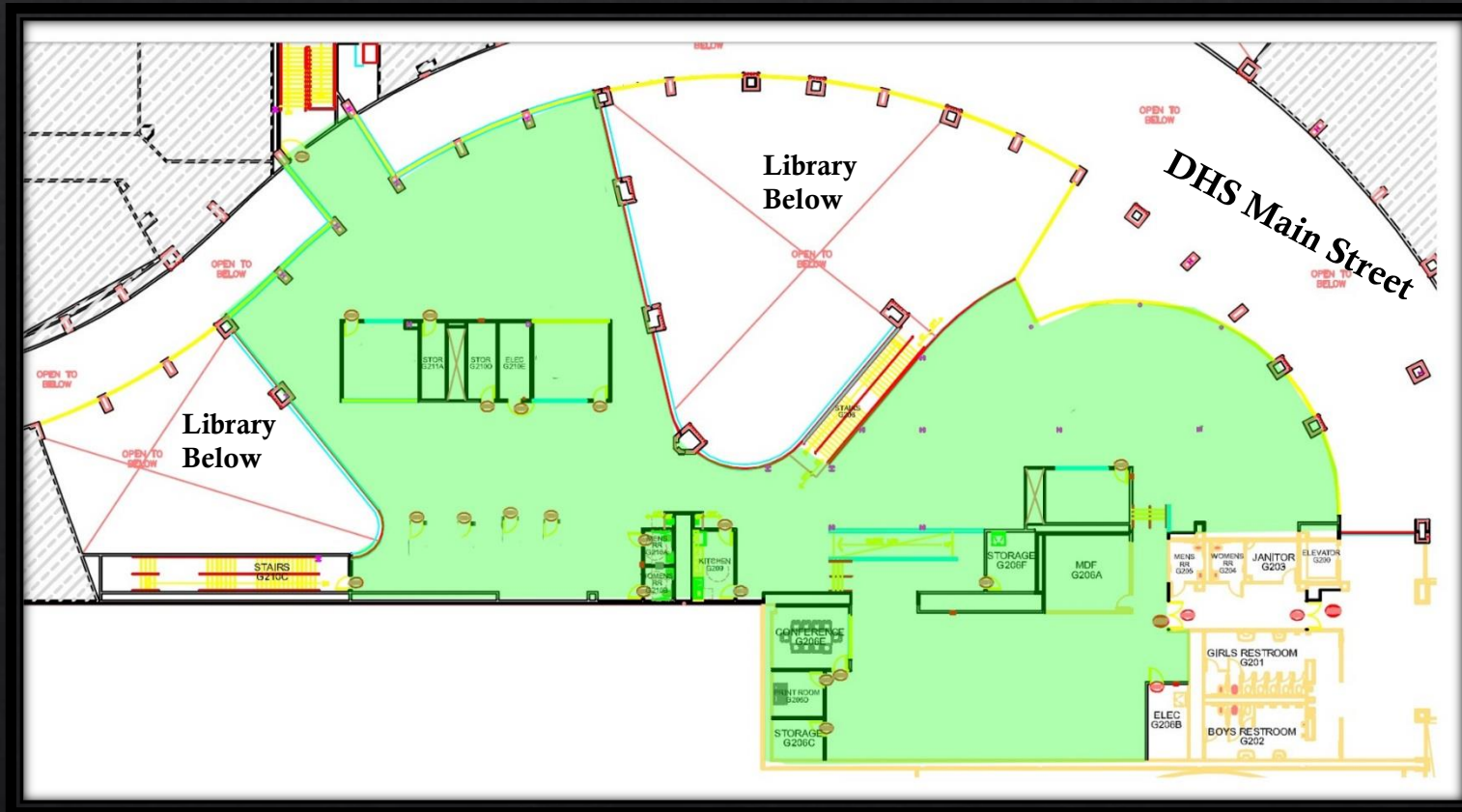
Other Information:

The classes will be taught by DHS faculty with the proper credentials and a master's degree in that subject area

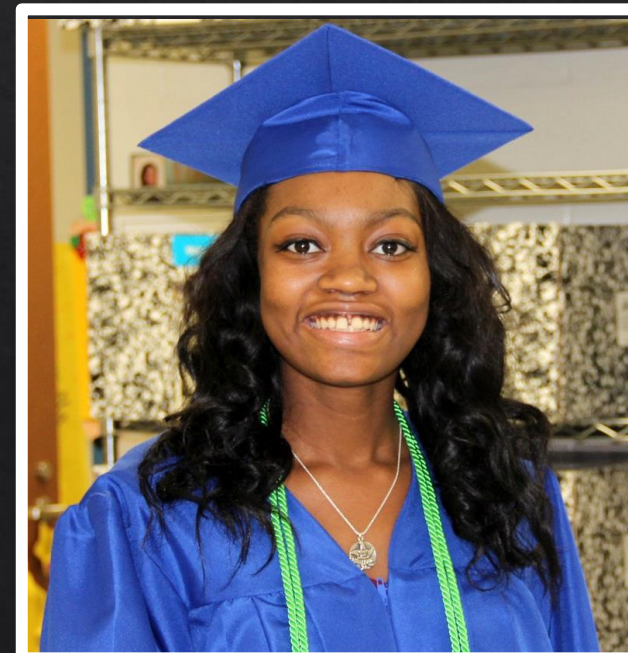
Information about the program is already being publicized
