TASFA Application becomes available October 1. Visit www.collegeforalltexans.com to access application.



Submit paper TASFA
application to UTAFAO with:
a. Student and Parent tax return
transcripts (www.irs.gov).
b. Selective Service
Registration Card/Letter if male
and at least age 18
(www.sss.gov).



Submit Senate Bill 1528
Residency Affidavit to UTA
Admissions Office
(www.uta.edu/admissions).



Submit a final high school transcript to UTA Admissions Office as soon you graduate. a. If transferring, also submit previous college(s) transcipts.



Priority date is January 15 for incoming freshmen and other first time applicants.

- a. Must be admitted by January 15.
- b. Must submit completed TASFA application to UTAFAO by January15.



Here at UTA, TASFA applicants are only eligible for the TEXAS Grant Program. Visit collegeforalltexans.com for more details.



TASFA applicants will be awarded in July.



If awarded, you will be notified via UTA email, informing you to Accept/Decline your financial aid package on your MyMav Student Center.



10 days before courses start each Fall and Spring semester, financial aid will disburse to pay towards tuition and fees.



Renewal requirements for TEXAS Grant Program:
a. First year - meet UTA's Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy (SAP) (www.uta.edu/fao).

b. Second year and beyond must complete a minimum of 24 credit hours each year and maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA.



Renew your TASFA application each year beginning October 1.
