## Start of School Spotlight: Virtual Learning and Device **Distribution**



The first day of school this year will look very different than in years past. Like other districts across the nation, Duncanville ISD administrators have been working hard to ensure we are prepared to welcome our students whether in person or virtually.


Preparation includes meeting our technology needs. This summer, the Duncanville ISD Board of Trustees approved \$2.8 million for our Technology Department to purchase new devices including iPads, Chromebooks, student and staff laptops and hotspots. The Technology Department has ordered almost 6,000 new devices. Due to the demand from districts throughout the state and the country, not all of those devices will be here before the start of school. As new devices arrive, they'll be deployed to students and staff.

To help increase internet connectivity throughout the district, the Technology Department is partnering with the Transportation Department to outfit four school buses with WiFi that will be parked in areas that are most in need of internet service. In addition, nearly 40 outdoor wireless antennas are being installed in campus parking lots across the district. There will be more information coming on how to access the internet through those resources.

## lew Teacher Welcome Includes Lunch & Swag Bac


