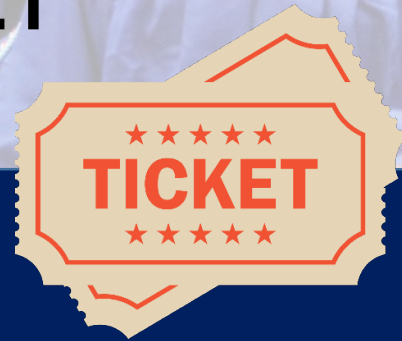

Ticket Pick-Up:

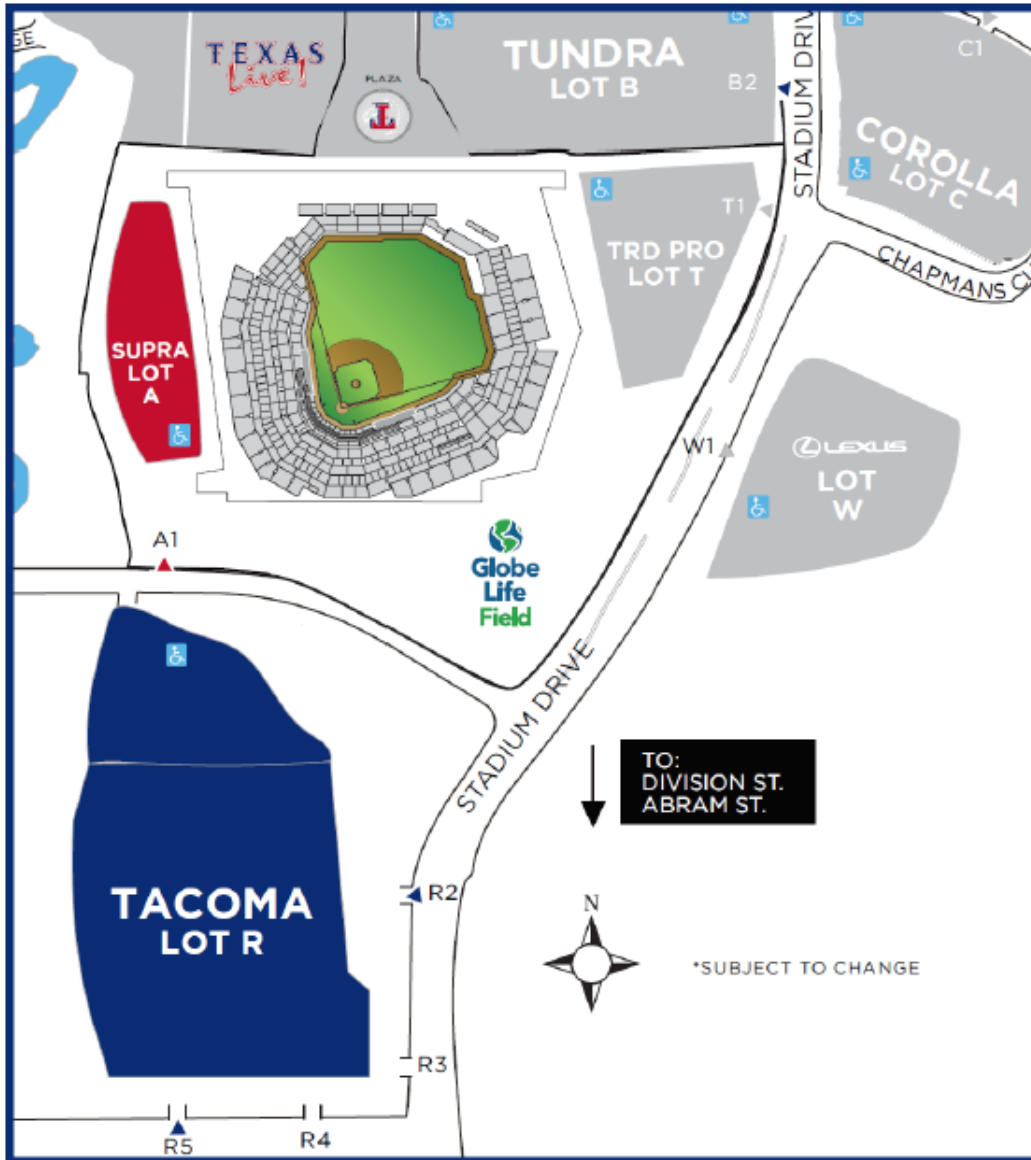
Graduating seniors can pick up their ticket and name cards at Duncanville High School on Saturday, June 5 from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. in main entrance parking lot. Students can also pick up their cap, gown and cords if they haven't done so.

Family and friends will no longer need a ticket to enter Globe Life Field and can sit on the Main Concourse level. If the Main Concourse becomes full, stadium staff will direct families to additional seating. Graduating seniors will still need to bring their admission ticket to gain access to their seat and the field.

There will be live streaming for family and friends who will be celebrating at home. Check our district website and our social media for the live stream link once it becomes available.



Parking Map and Guidelines



■ FACULTY LOT ■ STUDENT & GUEST LOT

Duncanville ISD faculty and staff will park in **LOT A** and enter through the West Market Place entrance.

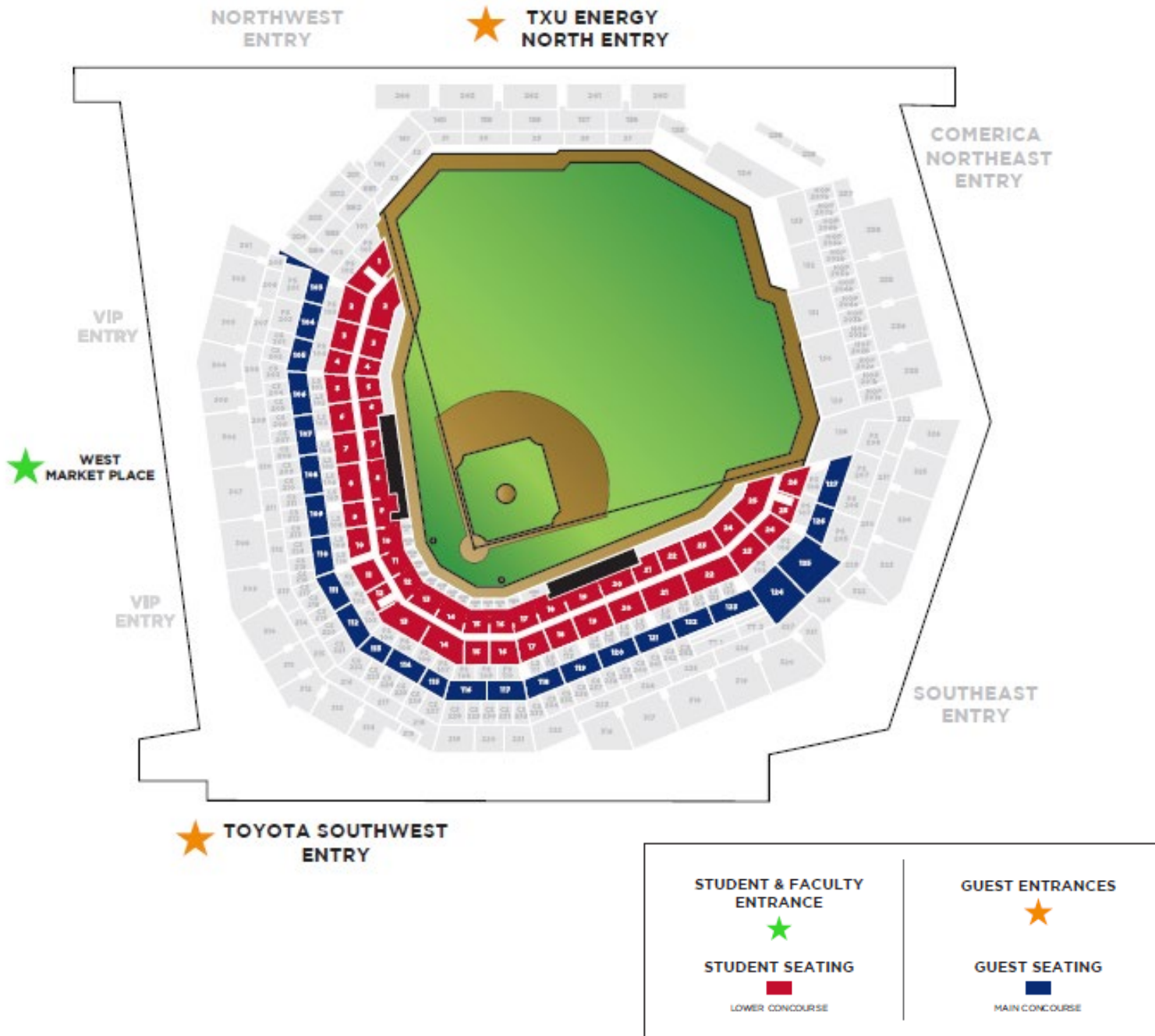
All graduates and guests/families will park in **LOT R** and enter through the Southwest or TXU Energy North entrances. Handicap parking is available on a first come, first served basis.

Parking lots will open at 6:30 p.m. (30 minutes before doors open).

Doors open at 7 p.m. (1 hour prior to ceremony start).

Guests/families can arrive up to 1 hour prior to the ceremony start time.

Guests/families must enter at the SOUTHWEST or TXU ENERGY entrance.



Safety Measures

To ensure the safety of our graduates, their families, guests and all school personnel, the following safety measures will be enacted.

Any graduate, family member or guest exhibiting any of the following COVID-19 symptoms will not be allowed admittance into Globe Life Field. Those found with any of these signs or symptoms will be excluded from the activity.

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature equal to or greater than 100 degrees Fahrenheit
- Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19 within the last 14 days

Safety Measures

Nursing staff will take the temperature of every student and school personnel entering the venue. Anyone with a measured temperature equal to or greater than 100 degrees Fahrenheit will not be allowed admittance. Graduates will be required to pass a health screening prior to arriving at Globe Life Field.

Assigned ticket seating will be strictly enforced for graduates to ensure proper social distancing.

All graduates and school personnel are strongly encouraged to wear a face covering while entering and exiting the venue and throughout the entire ceremony. Guests and family members are also strongly encouraged to wear a face covering while inside the venue.

Graduates are strongly encouraged to wear a face covering while walking on the field. Face coverings are recommended to remain on until the student is the second person from home plate to receive their diploma. At that time, the student has the option to remove their face covering while they walk across home plate or leave it on. It is strongly encouraged to put the face covering back on once they have crossed the plate and walk back to their seat.

Gloves are highly encouraged and optional, unless you are a staff member presenting items such as a diploma.

Hand sanitizer/hand washing stations will be available at all venue entrances.

Concession stands will be open. Students and guests may bring in one sealed water bottle.

Students and families may not loiter before or after graduation.



Stadium Rules

Tailgating is not permitted. Congregating before and after each ceremony is prohibited.



No noisemakers, glitter, balloons, confetti or streamers will be allowed into Globe Life Field. No weapons of any kind, even if registered. No clothing with offensive or profane language.

Graduates are not allowed to wear pointy high heeled shoes so as to protect the new baseball field and the student. Pointy heels will sink into the dirt field and get stuck. Wedged heels and non slippery shoes are encouraged.

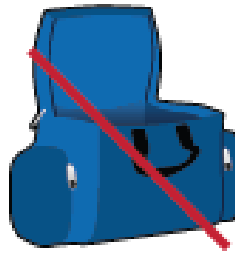
NO bags will be allowed in the venue, unless it is a medical bag or diaper bag.



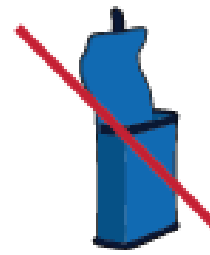

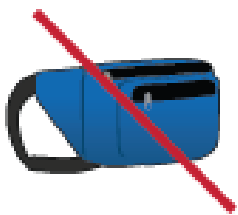

Day-of Procedures for Students

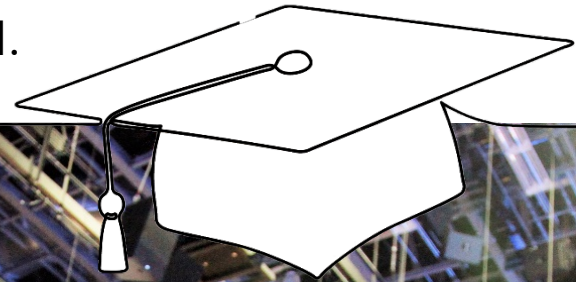
Students will need to be in their graduation cap and gown and present their ticket for admittance into the venue. Students will enter through the West Market Place entrance.

Decorations on your cap or stole are not permitted.

Students need to arrive 1 hour before the event to be seated. The graduate's ticket will provide directions to their assigned seat. Please sit in your assigned seat.

Students are to practice social distancing during the entirety of the program, which includes entrance into the venue. Stand six feet apart when in line on the field.

Guest and Ticket Information

Each graduate will receive 1 ticket for themselves in order to gain access to Globe Life Field.

Families will no longer need a ticket to enter Globe Life Field. Duncanville ISD has collaborated with Globe Life Field to allow general admission for guests.

General admission seating will be available on the Main Concourse level on a first-come, first-serve basis. If the Main Concourse becomes full, stadium staff will direct guests to additional seating. The doors will open at 7 p.m. for guests to enter the venue.



Families must complete a pre-screening survey to assess their medical condition over the previous 14 days. Duncanville High School will begin communicating the pre-screening closer to graduation via social media, newsletter and School Messenger.

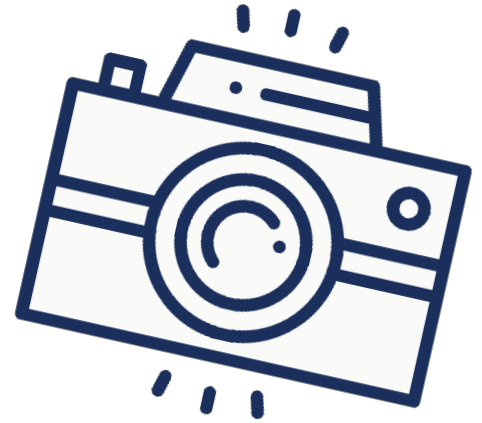




Photos and Dismissal

Once a graduate has received his/her diploma, he/she will walk to the home plate where a professional photographer will take one official photo only. Students may remove their face coverings for the photo.

Diplomas and transcripts will be available for curbside pick-up on Thursday, June 24 from 8 a.m. – 6:30 p.m. at Duncanville High School. Please have your student ID or state issued ID.

Graduates and guests will be dismissed by section by an announcer. Please wait for the announcer to dismiss your section. After your section has been dismissed, please exit the venue and head to your car. Congregating after the ceremony is prohibited.
